Change the CSS of an HTML Element Using Javascript

- Store an HTML element in a variable:
 var divTwo = document.getElementByld("two");
- 2) Set a style property using the following format: divTwo.style.propertyName = value;

JS vs CSS Property Syntax

CSS uses hyphens '-' to combine two words

```
p {
    background-color: red;
}

JS uses camelCase

divTwo.style.backgroundColor = "red";
```

JS vs CSS Property Syntax

With JS, we often need to use "quotes" around the values.

```
#blah {
    width: 500px;
}
```

document.getElementById("blah").style.width = "500px";

Which CSS properties can we edit with JS?

All of them.

The syntax is just different, as we just saw.
