



JavaScript: Logical Operators: And/Or

Review

(Don't write this down, you already have it in your notes)

If - Statement:

A control structure that allows programmers to make decisions

boolean:

A value that can be **true** or **false**

comparison operator: a symbol that **compares** two values

Definitions

logical operator:

a symbol that links two or more booleans into a larger boolean statement

We have symbols that represent and and or

And

symbol: &&

rules:

If **both sides are true**, the whole expression is **true**
Otherwise, the whole expression is **false**

example:

```
if (age > 12 && age <= 19) {  
    console.log("You are a teenager");  
}
```

Or

symbol: ||

rules:

If **either side is true**, the whole expression is **true**

Only if both sides are false is the whole expression **false**

example:

```
if(letter == "a" || letter == "e") {  
    console.log("Letter is a vowel");  
}
```
