1. Bootstrap uses a lot of divs
  2. To use Bootstrap styling, give your elements Bootstrap class names
  3. You can add your own CSS to customize Bootstrap

# Container and Container-Fluid

- Bootstrap-styled sections of your website need to be wrapped in one div with a class of container or container-fluid
- container is a fixed width with margins on the right and left
- container-fluid is full window width

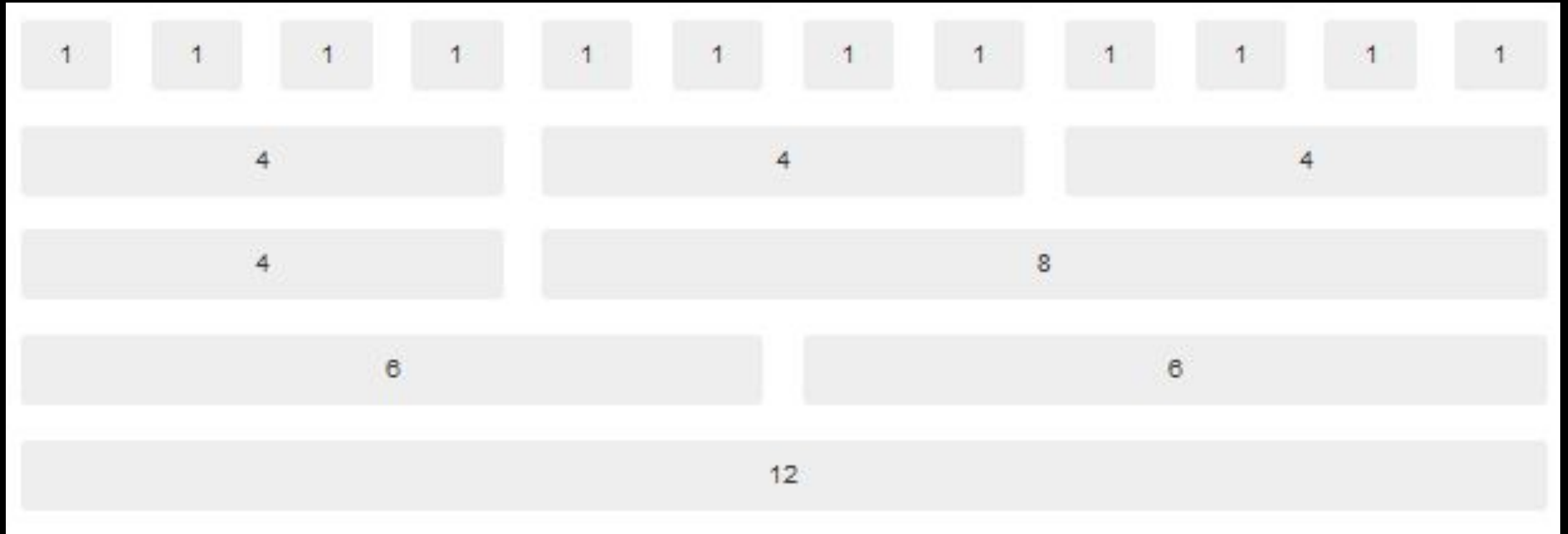

# Bootstrap Responsive Grid

- Bootstrap makes it very easy to make horizontal rows that automatically switch to vertical when viewed on smaller screens
- Use divs with Bootstrap classes to create the grid
- The grid is 12 columns wide
- You can make columns span more than one, but all columns in a row must add up to 12

# Bootstrap Responsive Grid

How To:

1. Start with a `<div class="row">`
2. Inside of the div, create divs to represent columns with `<div class="col-md-___">` where you fill in the blank with any number 1-12
3. All div numbers within the row must add up to 12
4. Add content to your column divs
